A Crisis of Confidence ... Tehran's Power Dynamics Post-Haniyeh Assassination

The world's attention swiftly shifted from the inauguration of Iran's new president, Masoud Bazshikan, to an event with potentially far greater significance: the assassination of Ismail Haniyeh, the head of the political bureau of the Palestinian Hamas movement, in his residence in Tehran.
